



Foundation Software API Accelerator Service

About the FieldLogix API Accelerator Service

FieldLogix provides a service that tracks the current and past locations of field technicians through a GPS tracking device installed in their vehicles or a smartphone app with wireless connectivity. The system provides an API that can update 3rd party systems with information such as the technicians' names, current locations, update times, etc. The Foundation Software API Accelerator Service is designed to update the Foundation Software database with these records without requiring custom software development.

Access

The API Accelerator is a .exe program that is loaded on the server that hosts the Foundation database and it runs as a service. Please reach out to support@fieldlogix.com to request a copy of the API Accelerator.

Functionality

The FieldLogix Foundation Software API Accelerator is designed to insert values in your Foundation Software database to display technician arrival and departure times for dispatched jobs. The tool checks and updates the data in 2 minute intervals. It must be deployed as a Windows service on the server that hosts your Foundation Software database. It is compatible with Foundation software running .Net framework version 4 and above.

Behavior

When new jobs are added to Foundation Software's **sd_dispatch** table, the tool will create a corresponding landmark/geofence in FieldLogix with a 0.05 radius.

When the technicians arrive at the jobsite, the tool will post the arrival time in the **sd_dispatchbillings** table in the **start_time** column for the same job. When the vehicle leaves the jobsite, the tool will post a departure time in the **end_time** column.

Installation Instructions

Use of the FieldLogix Foundation Software API Accelerator service is **bound by the Terms of Service** as displayed in this document. If you do not consent to the Terms of Service, you must not install or run the API Accelerator.

1. Create a new user in FieldLogix dedicated to your API account. You can name it “APImycompanyname”, etc. We recommend that you give it full fleet access in settings. (Settings > Manage Users > Add User)
2. [Download & unzip the file located here](#) and save the folder containing the API Accelerator on your server.
3. Open the folder titled “Release” and click on **Setup1.exe** to install the program and register the API tool in Windows. *Document the path of the folder that you save the program to.*
4. Find the **API_Tool.exe.config** file within the FOUNDATION_API folder, open with Text Edit, change the following settings (a full copy of API_Tool.exe.config file found on page 7 of this document), and save the file.

For “customer_source”, enter your Foundation Software database’s IP address and DB instance name as the value (i.e. 192.168.1.1\YOUR_DB_INSTANCE_NAME).

For “customer_catalog”, enter your Foundation Software database’s name as the value.

“customer_table”, is pre-configured for the **sd_dispatchbillings** table.

For “customer_username”, enter your designated Foundation Software database user’s username as the value.

For “customer_password”, enter your designated Foundation Software database user’s password as the value *****See security recommendation below*****

For “WEBSITE_LOGIN”, enter your FieldLogix username as the value

For “WEBSITE_PASSWORD”, enter your FieldLogix password as the value.

For “SiteSelection”, enter 0 for the production environment. (1 is the setting for the development environment).

5. If you create a special DB user for the FieldLogix in the Foundation Software database, please ensure that the user has permissions to **read** from the **sd_dispatch** table and can **read & insert** records (**read/write/update**) into the **sd_dispatch_billings** table.
6. The log file would be stored in **C:\ProgramData\FieldLogix\API** and is named “**log.txt**”. Verify that this folder has **read/write** access within **Properties**.
7. To run the API Accelerator as a service, **open a command window** on your server (right click on the program icon and select run as administrator) and enter the following (press the **Enter** key after each line):

C:\>cd "C:\Windows\Microsoft.NET\Framework64\v4.0.30319"

C:\Windows\Microsoft.NET\Framework64\v4.0.30319>InstallUtil.exe "C:\Program Files (x86)\FieldLogix\FOUNDATION_API\API_Tool.exe"




If the above command fails, try:

```
sc.exe create API_TOOL binPath= "C:\Program Files  
(x86)\FieldLogix\FOUNDATION_API\API_Tool.exe"
```

(note that the items in **blue font** may require a change if you saved the folder on a different drive or location. You can also paste the path of the folder as described in Step 2 after ...InstallUtil.exe).

6. Go to Administrative Tools > Services on your server and click right click to select service. Then find the service named **FieldLogix Foundation API Tool**, right click, and select start.



7. You should now see data populating in the **start_time** and **end_time** columns in the **sd_dispatch_billings** table as the vehicles drive to the dispatched jobs throughout the day. We recommend that you check the table one business day after installing the tool to verify that the data is populating properly.

To UnInstall the Tool

Open the Command Prompt and enter the text below:

*****Security recommendation:** We advise you to create a new user account for your Foundation Software database specifically for the API Accelerator. This user account should be restricted to read only access to sd_dispatch and read/write/update access to the sd_dispatch_billing tables in your database.
